				<p><u>Exits</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. All exits marked and illuminated by reliable light source?</li> <li>2. Doors, passageways, or stairways that are not exits nor accessible to exits appropriately marked?</li> <li>3. "Exit" sign lettering at least 6 inches high and 3/4 inch wide?</li> <li>4. Exit doors side-hinged?</li> <li>5. All exits free of obstructions?</li> <li>6. Sufficient exits to permit prompt emergency escape?</li> <li>7. Where ramps are used as required exit, is ramp slope limited to 1 foot vertical and 12 foot horizontal?</li> <li>8. If frameless glass doors, glass exit doors, storm doors, etc., are doors fully tempered and meet safety requirements for human impact?</li> <li>9. Exit doors open from the direction of exit travel without the use of a key or any special knowledge or effort?</li> <li>10. Where panic hardware is installed on exit door, will it allow the door to open with 15 pounds or less force in the direction of the exit traffic?</li> <li>11. Exit doors opening onto street, alley, or vehicle parking area provided with adequate barriers and warnings to prevent employees stepping into traffic or vehicles blocking exit?</li> </ol>

Pits and floor openings covered or guarded?</li><li>4. Aisle clearance provided for motorized or mechanical handling equipment operation?</li><li>5. Walkways properly marked?</li><li>6. Aisles and walkways passing near moving or operating machinery, welding operations or similar operations arranged to minimize potential hazard exposure?</li><li>7. Adequate headroom provided for entire length of walkway?</li><li>8. Bridges provided over conveyors and similar hazards?</li></ol>
