

GASOLINE HANDLING AND STORAGE

1. Gasoline will not be stored in open, plastic, or glass containers.
2. Gasoline or other flammable fuels shall be stored in approved safety cans, approved flammable liquid storage cabinets, or approved flammable liquid storage tanks.
3. Metallic contact shall be maintained between containers when dispensing gasoline or other flammable fuels from one metal container to another.
4. Gasoline will not be stored in places where there is no ventilation, near combustible materials, near electrical equipment, or close to any source of fire.
5. All storage containers shall be conspicuously labeled "FLAMMABLE" and shall bear the name of the substance stored therein.
6. Employees shall not siphon gasoline by mouth suction from tanks or containers.
7. Never use gasoline in an engine that uses diesel fuel.
8. Do not transport gasoline unless in an approved container and not hauled inside car or truck cabs.
9. Never use gasoline for cleaning purposes.
10. Mixing of two or more flammable fuels shall be prohibited.
11. Never pour or handle gasoline around open or unprotected flames, electrical equipment, areas where sparks or static electricity may be present, or in unventilated places.
12. Care shall be exercised in fueling motor vehicles or gasoline powered equipment. Spillage shall be avoided. All engines shall be turned off during fueling. Use of any ignition source near a fueling operation shall be prohibited.
