## Heavy Equipment Scrapers



- 1. Do not try to climb on or off the machine when carrying tools or supplies.
  - a. Use a hand line to pull equipment up onto the platform.
- 2. Check for proper operation of all controls and protective devices while moving slowly in an open area.
- 3. Operate the machine only while seated.
- 4. Operate the controls only with the engine running.
- 5. Do not allow riders on the machine unless additional seat, seat belt, and rollover protection are provided.
- 6. Carry bowl close to the ground, approximately 40cm (15 in) above ground level.
- 7. Stay a safe distance from the edge of cliffs, overhangs, and slide areas.
- 8. If the machine begins to sideslip on a grade, lower the bowl and bring the machine to a safe stop.
- 9. Be careful to avoid the condition which could lead to tipping when working on hills, banks, or slopes, and when crossing ditches, ridges, or other obstructions.
- 10. Work up and down slopes, rather than sideways, whenever possible.
- 11. Keep the machine under control and do not work it over its capacity.
- 12. Personnel are prohibited from being between the machines and trailing equipment when maneuvering to connect them.
  - a. Block the tongue or hitch of trailing equipment to align it with the drawbar or hitch.
- 13. Park on a level surface. If necessary to park on a grade, block the machine.
  - a. Lower bowl to the ground and apply slight down pressure. Stop the engine.
