Have a Plan Before the Storm

Summer storms can move in quickly. The best time to prepare is before dark clouds appear.

Before you begin work each day, identify your nearest sturdy shelter and keep an eye on changing weather conditions throughout the day.

Note: Vehicles, temporary job trailers and open equipment are NOT safe shelters during tornado warnings.

Remember this simple rule: When Thunder Roars, Go Indoors.

If severe weather develops, stay away from windows and never drive through flooded roads. If you can delay travel until conditions improve, do it.

After a storm passes, watch for hazards like downed power lines, debris and slippery surfaces before getting back to work.

A little preparation goes a long way. Look out for yourself, look out for your coworkers and help make sure everyone gets home safe.
