

Earthmoving Equipment



These rules apply to the following types of earthmoving equipment: scrapers, loaders, crawlers or wheel tractors, bulldozers, off-highway trucks, graders, agricultural and industrial tractors, and similar equipment.

1. Seat belts shall be provided and used when operating any of the above equipment.
2. Pneumatic-tired earthmoving haulage equipment whose maximum speed exceeds 15 mph shall be equipped with fenders on all wheels.
3. All of the above vehicles must be equipped with rollover protective structures.
4. All of the above vehicles shall be equipped with a horn, which shall be operated as needed when the vehicle is moving in either direction.
 - The horn shall be maintained in an operative condition.
 - Earthmoving equipment which has an obstructed view to the rear and is to be used in reverse gear, shall have in operation a reverse signal alarm distinguishable from the surrounding noise level or shall have an employee signal that it is safe to back up.
