

Floor Buffers

General Safety - Safe Operation

1. Read carefully the Safety Instructions before plugging machine into a properly grounded outlet.
2. Always keep a floor buffer in good operating condition.
3. Always unplug the floor buffer from an electrical outlet when not in use.
4. Always wear appropriate clothing when operating the floor buffer.
5. Always check for damaged cords and plugs.
6. Never pull or carry the floor buffer by the cord.
7. Never run the buffer over cord.
8. Never unplug the floor buffer by pulling cord.
9. Do not twist grip with handle in the upright position.
10. Do not plug machine into a power source other than indicated on machine nameplate.
11. Do not use machine in areas where flammable liquids or vapors may be present.

Safety Tips

1. Keep floors in good condition, repair cracks, loose or missing tiles as soon as possible.
2. Keep floors clean and dry; wipe up spills immediately.
3. Follow directions carefully when using floor cleansers and waxes.
4. Arrange furniture to provide as much clear area as possible.
5. Use 'WET FLOOR' Caution signs when necessary.
