

Loading Rack Operations



1. The operator shall be trained in the loading rack operation.
2. Loading rack piping shall be grounded.
3. Trucks shall be grounded with a ground cable when loading.
4. To prevent buildup of static electricity, wear rubber boots or shoes with rubber heels.
5. When checking the load, use an approved flashlight.
6. The use of open lights and extension cords is prohibited.
7. The operator shall know how to use the firefighting equipment on the loading rack.
8. Stop the loading operation during electrical storms.
9. Swing joints on the load rack will turn freely.
10. Swing joints will be inspected for leaks. The loading arms will have a velocity check valve.
11. Trucks will be kept a distance from the loading racks while loaded.
12. Inspect the tanks, valves, hoses, lines, and loading equipment.
13. Inspect the truck for leaks.
14. When not in use, hoses or loading arms shall be placed on the rack supports.
15. Trucks transporting hazardous materials shall be so placarded to identify the product.
