

Power Nailers and Staplers



1. Always read and understand the instructions before using the equipment.
2. Use extreme caution when using nail guns; be aware of other personnel in the area.
 - a. Make sure no one is in the line of fire or standing close by when nailing.
3. Do not point a loaded or an empty tool at any one.
4. Nail guns must be lubricated before each day's use to help keep them working properly.
5. Inspect hoses for cracks before each use and replace when necessary.
6. When changing attachments, disconnect from the power source.
7. Never hoist or lower the nail gun by the hose.
8. Equipment will be grounded.
9. Equipment will have a power switch that is manually held in the on position.
10. Report any equipment that shows wear or inadequate insulation.
11. Do not put hands over the ejection points.
12. When not in use, keep nail guns and hoses in crew vehicles or toolboxes.
