Workforce Safety & Insurance (WSI) was a victim of a cyber-attack. A North Dakota Information Technology Department (ITD) server that contained certain WSI data files was accessed by hackers. As of now, there is no evidence that the cyber-attackers moved or duplicated any WSI data.

The server contained WSI Incident Reports and Payroll Reports filed online between 2006 and 2013. These reports may include personal information, such as names and social security numbers. No injured worker claim file information was contained on the breached server.

WSI takes security of personal information seriously. As a result, WSI has sent letters directly to affected individuals for whom an address was available. WSI has also reached out to the media to enlist their help in informing the public of this incident. As an additional effort, with this letter, WSI is reaching out to employers. We are asking employers to consider contacting past and present employees to direct them to <http://www.WorkforceSafety.com/security> where additional information about the security breach is available.

In addition, WSI has contracted with AllClear ID., a nationally recognized company that specializes in identity protection services to help affected individuals. AllClear ID will provide credit repair services, free of charge, to all affected individuals.

We recommend that employees monitor their credit report for any unauthorized activity and contact AllClear ID. The toll-free number for AllClear ID can be found at:
