WEAR THE RIGHT GLOVES

- Gloves can pull you in if they get caught

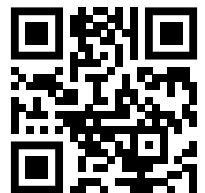
AVOID LINE-OF-FIRE HAZARDS

- Use guards, push tools, and safe hand placement
- Never rush; reposition if needed

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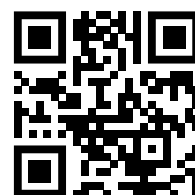
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
