- 3 Amputation claims with Total Incurred Costs of \$165,778.83
- Length of employment
 - 1 year or less – 75 claims (54.3%)
 - 2 – 5 years – 31 claims (22.5%)
 - 6 – 10 years – 10 claims (7.2%)
 - 11 – 20 years – 5 claims (3.6%)
 - 20+ years – 10 claims (7.2%)
 - Uncoded – 7 claims (5.1%)
- Age at Time of injury
 - 18 – 29: 37 claims (26.8%)
 - 30 – 39: 34 claims (24.6%)
 - 40 – 49: 24 claims (17.4%)
 - 50 – 59: 27 claims (19.6%)
 - 60 – 65: 7 claims (5.1%)
 - Over 65: 9 claims (6.5%)
- Gender
 - Female – 36 claims (26.1%)
 - Male – 102 claims (73.9%)
