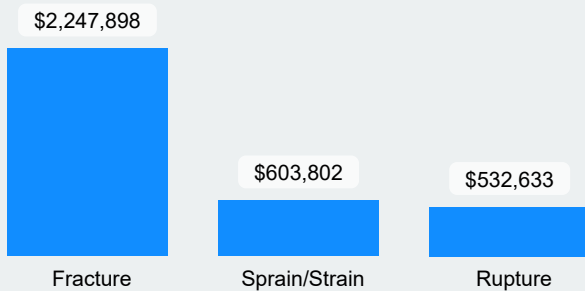

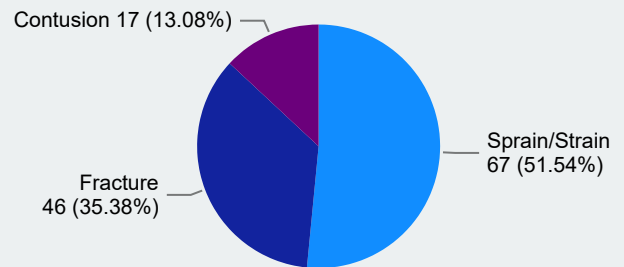

Top 3 Time Loss Claims by Incurred Costs

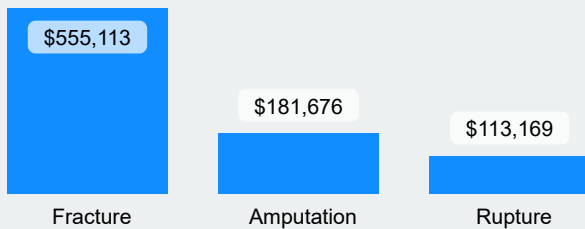


Top 3 Time Loss Claims by Claim Count

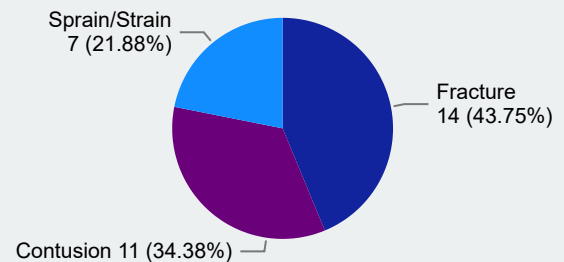

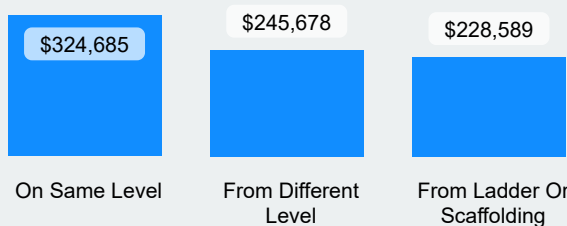
Top 3 Nature of Injury by Incurred Costs



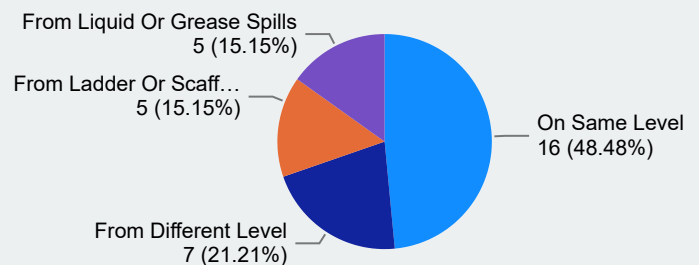
Top 3 Nature of Injury by Claim Count



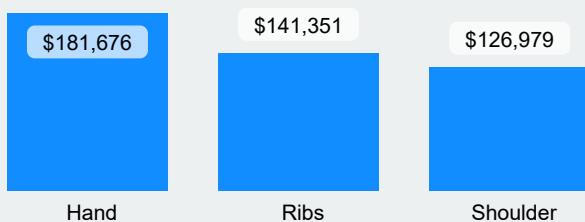
Top 3 Injury Cause by Incurred Costs



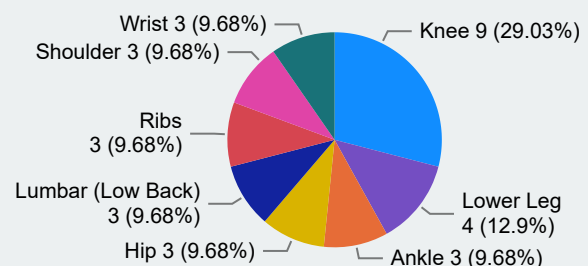
Top 3 Injury Cause by Claim Count

Top 3 Body Part Claims by Claim Count



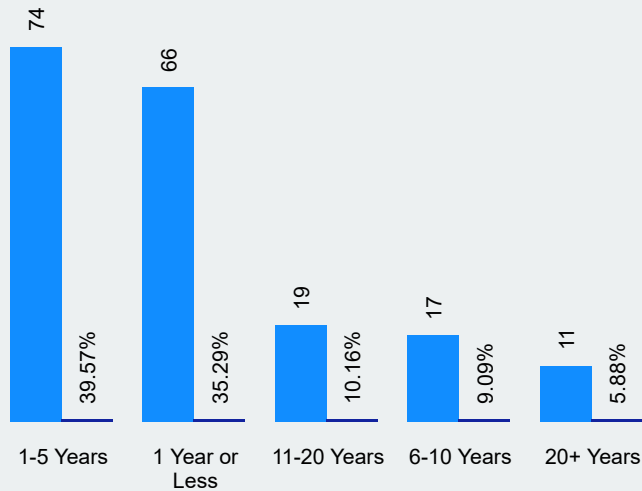
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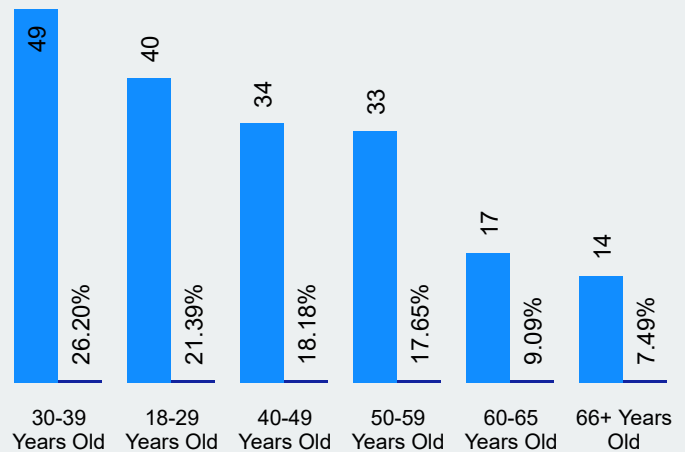


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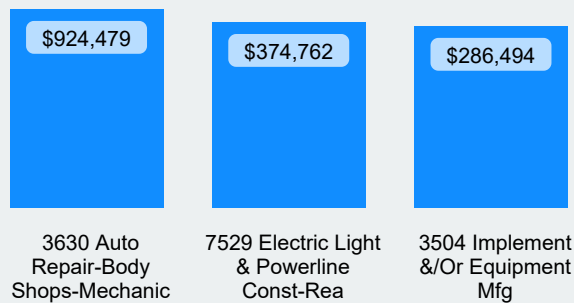

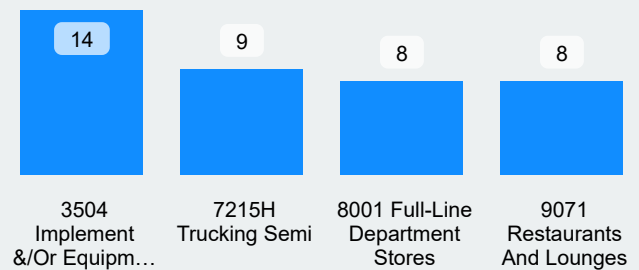

2022 - PS5-102043	2022 - Preventing Slips, Trips and Falls: In the Event of a Fall	Are there right and wrong ways to fall down? The answer is yes. Take this course to learn how you can make the best of a bad situation and minimize your injuries. This course is ideal for all employees.
