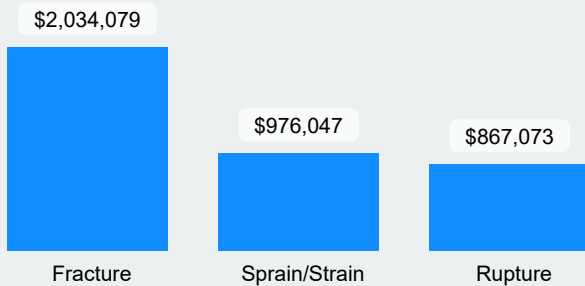

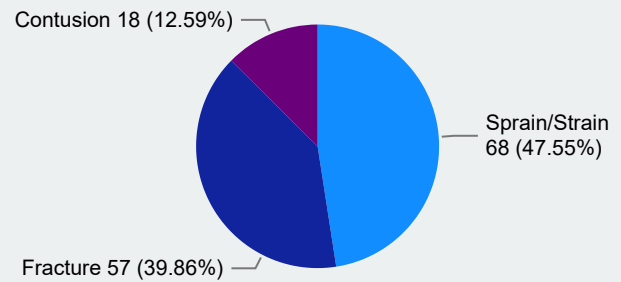

### Top 3 Time Loss Claims by Incurred Costs

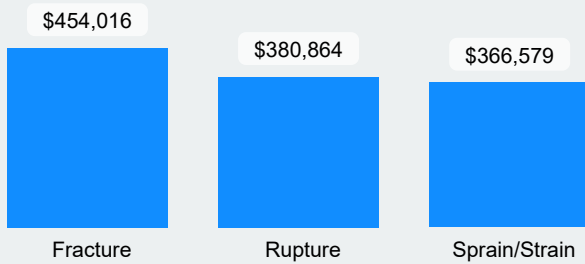


### Top 3 Time Loss Claims by Claim Count

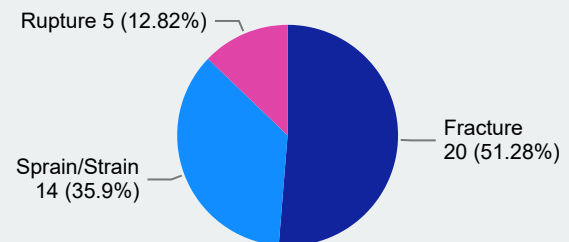

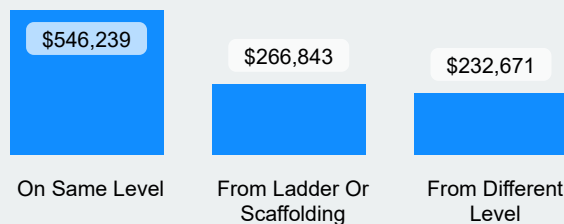
### Top 3 Nature of Injury by Incurred Costs



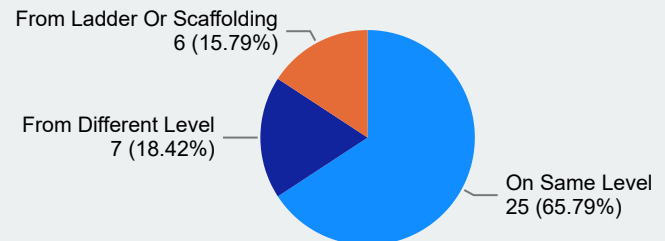
### Top 3 Nature of Injury by Claim Count



### Top 3 Injury Cause by Incurred Costs



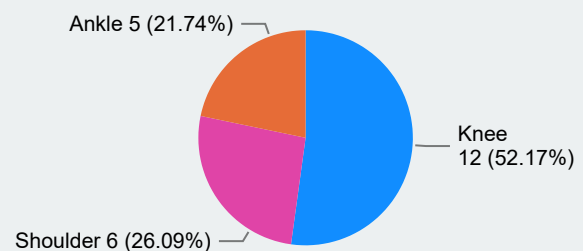
### Top 3 Injury Cause by Claim Count

### Top 3 Body Part Claims by Claim Count



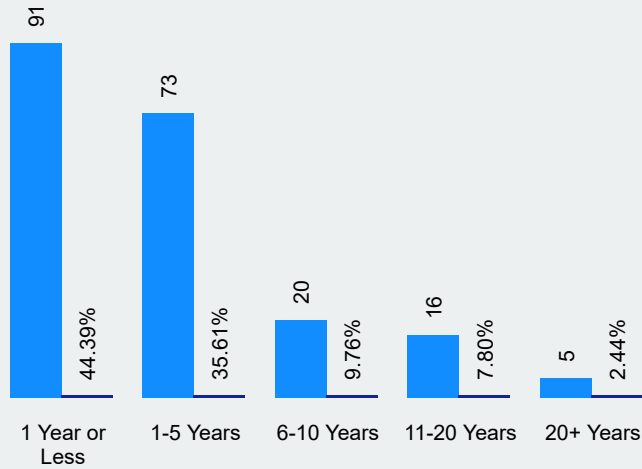

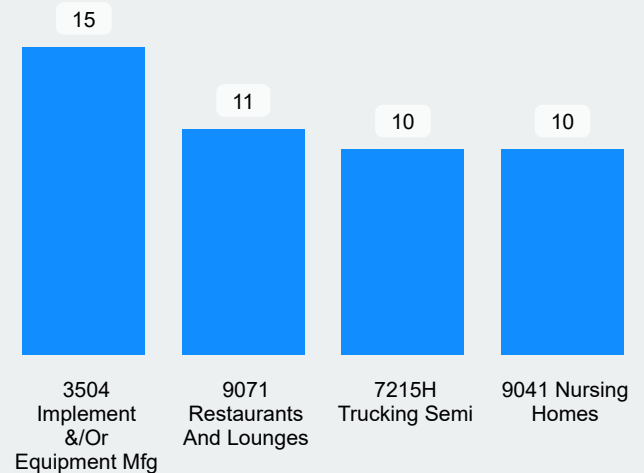
