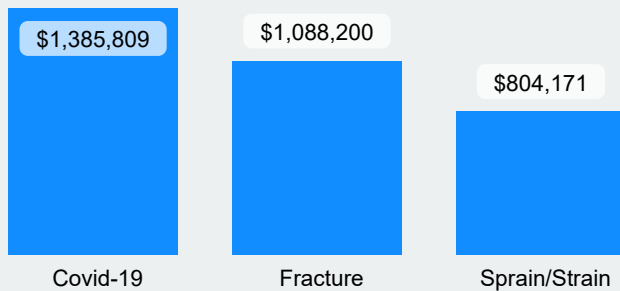

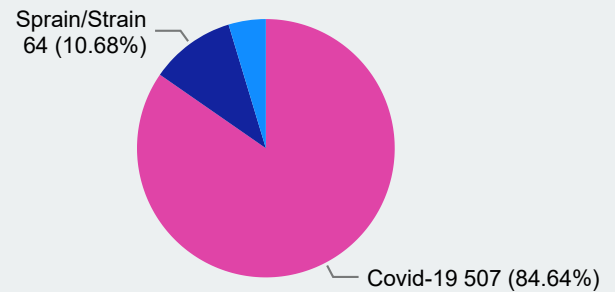

Top 3 Time Loss Claims by Incurred Costs

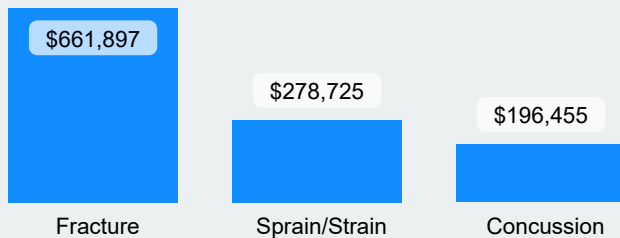


Top 3 Time Loss Claims by Claim Count

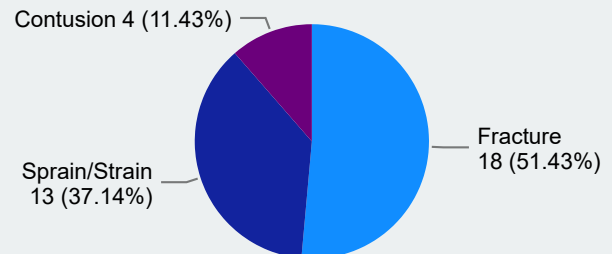

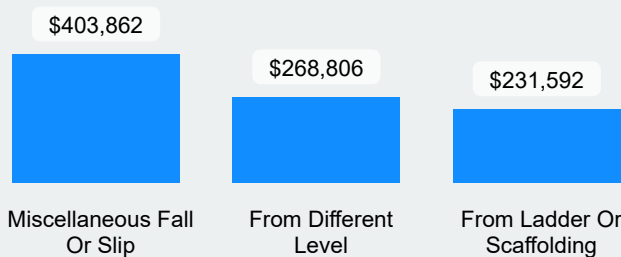
Top 3 Nature of Injury by Incurred Costs



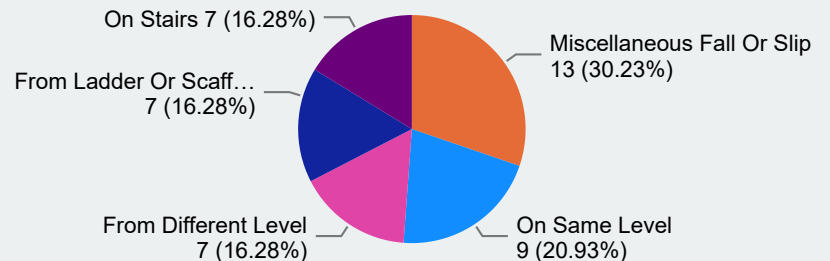
Top 3 Nature of Injury by Claim Count



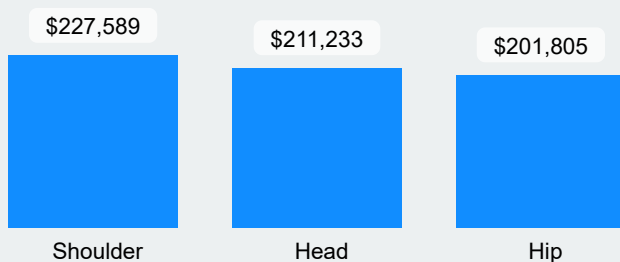
Top 3 Injury Cause by Incurred Costs



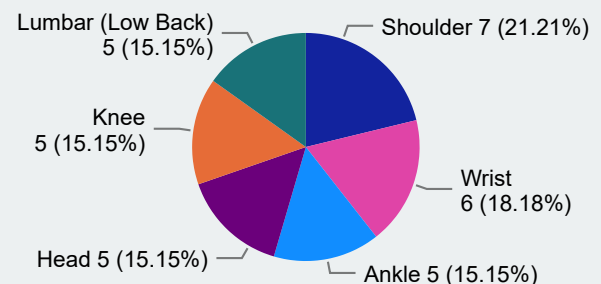
Top 3 Injury Cause by Claim Count

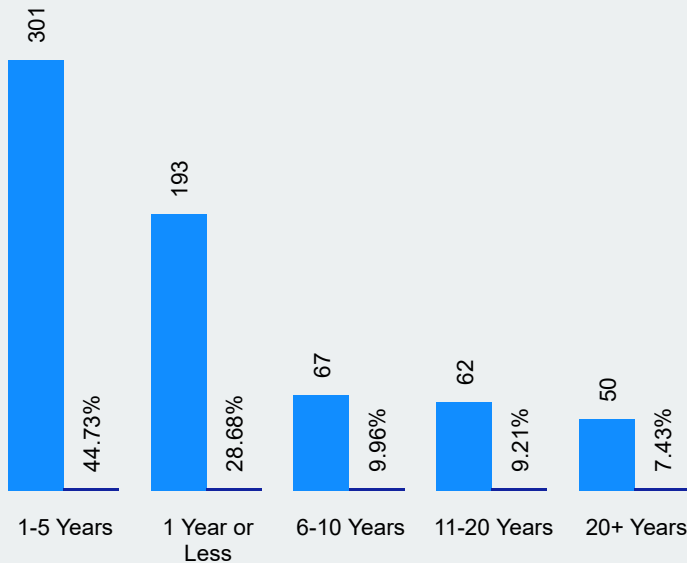

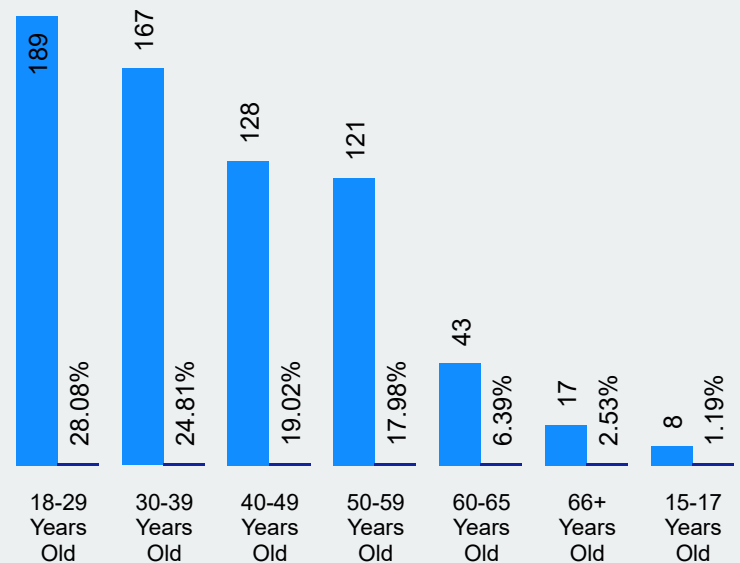

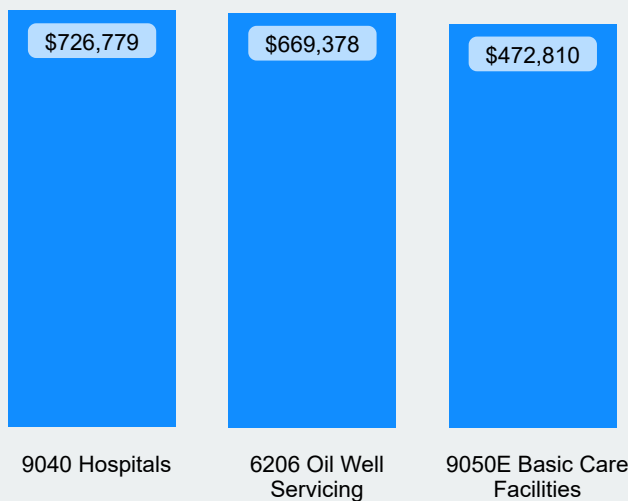

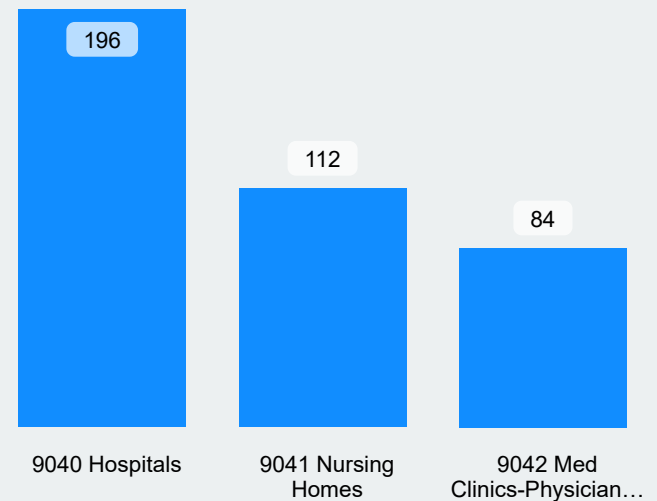
