

Safety Training and Education Program (S.T.E.P.) Grant Recipients

Workforce Safety and Insurance introduced the Safety Training and Education (STEP) program in 2007. The purpose of the STEP program is to provide financial assistance to promote safety practices through safety training and education. The program seeks to enlist the resources of North Dakota associations and employee organizations to assist in reducing injuries and accidents. An association is a body of individuals or businesses operating under a common name, whether incorporated or not, who share common occupational risks and are grouped for a common cause or objective. Over \$10.2 million has been awarded through the STEP program through December 2024.
